Current tunnel and RF nodes. EOC and hospitals node possible locations

Operational KCMesh services:

Ip phone. Metro wide and nationwide. Upstream network changes have corrected call dropouts KCmeshChat, Auto posting of Weather warnings and statements.

Web cameras. Shawnee and Holden.

Winlink messaging. RMS Relay is available to any AREDN mesh reachable. Locally KA2FNK-10 and KOJPR-10. KA2FNK-10 is a winlink Hybrid location. Messages can be sent and received via HF. KCmesh status map. Updates every 5 minutes.

KCMesh current work underway:

WY County EOC. Three nodes installed. Swapped out the Lan switch for adding weather station. Final node adjustment will be completed when the down steam nodes are installed.

Roswell Tower. The inside equipment, The UPS, Lan Switch, and lightning grounding has been installed. The three nodes and cabling are at the tower waiting for the tower climbers.

Truman (MCI) Have equipment. Looking to install after Roswell tower work.

Providence and St John hospitals. Some equipment on hand, rest will be purchased or donated once Roswell tower.

Advent, Shawnee. Need site survey to determine site requirements.

Ensor Farm and Museum. Node in place.

Need to follow up with Spring Hill High School for approval to local node there. There are two possible Hams that could then install nodes with a tunnel.

Johnson County ECS and Johnson County EM are on board and have started performing node location modeling.

Once we have active nodes, we will resubmit a revised grant request.
