

**MO-KAN COUNCIL OF AMATEUR RADIO CLUBS, INC.**

**POLICY ON FREQUENCY COORDINATION ACTIVITIES**

**February 13, 2016**

**ARTICLE 1. Purpose:**

The purpose of the policy on frequency coordination activities is to guide the activities of the Mo-Kan Council of Amateur Radio Clubs (the "Corporation") as it interacts with the other organizations or agencies charged with the purpose of frequency coordination in the Amateur Radio Service, and the amateur radio community as a whole. This policy is intended to supplement but not replace any applicable laws or regulations governing frequency coordination. The information set forth in this policy shall be used for all actual or potential dealings and interactions of the corporation.

**ARTICLE 2. Corporate Charter:**

- A) The Articles of Incorporation for the Mo-Kan Council of Amateur Radio Clubs, Inc. were filed in the State of Missouri on May 15, 1987, and certified by the Missouri Secretary of State on June 2, 1987.
- B) Section 6, Part A, Subpart 2 of the Articles of Incorporation includes among the purposes of the Corporation, "frequency coordination for amateur radio repeater stations." This is only one of six purposes of the organization enumerated in the Articles of Incorporation.
- C) It is known to the corporation that there are other existing organizations in Missouri and Kansas which are charged with the responsibility for frequency coordination, and that these other organizations are recognized by the Federal Communications Commission and the American Radio Relay League as the organizations, in fact, with the responsibility for frequency coordination within their geographical areas of responsibility.
- D) It is recognized by the corporation, that an additional organization, not charged by the Federal Communications Commission and / or the American Radio Relay League to conduct frequency coordination to insert itself into the frequency coordination process may be disruptive to the normal discourse of business, and cause confusion.

**ARTICLE 3. Policy:**

It shall be the policy of the Mo-Kan Council of Amateur Radio Clubs, Inc. to not be involved in the specific business of Frequency Coordination. This shall not preclude the corporation from discussing matters of frequency coordination, or offering opinions or comments on matters of frequency coordination.

**ARTICLE 4. Term:**

This policy, once approved by the board of directors of the corporation, shall remain in force until such time it is a) repealed by the board of directors, b) amended by the board of directors, c) section six of the Articles of Incorporation are amended, or d) the corporation is dissolved.
