8. Regular Business:

a. 2025 ARRL Division Convention:

- i. Discussion was made at the First Quarter Meeting on this topic. (See the Minutes for April 23, 2024, online.) Since that meeting, I have commitments from three organizations pledging their desire to support this effort. (I'd like to see more...)
- ii. Some research has been done which indicates a suitable venue in the Kansas City Metro would likely cost \$30K or more. A suggestion was made by the Delegation from Warrensburg Area ARC that we might look to Sedalia SPARK.
- iii. Randy Schulze spoke with ARRL MWD Director Art Zygielbaum to update him regarding our discussions, and the suggestion regarding Sedalia, home of the Missouri State Fair. After considering the location of Sedalia and other features, Art agreed, and asked if I might speak with Bret Kuhns, W0VK, the President of SPARK. A request was made to the Director that it was brought up at the First Quarter Meeting that if the Convention is held within the Mo-Kan Region, it should be planned to re-occur in the region on a regular basis. Art agreed.
- iv. Randy Schulze spoke with Bret Kuhns, from Sedilia Amateur Rado Club (SPARK,), and advised him of the high-level discussions thus far. Bret is excited about this opportunity and wants to start work to make this a success. Her has many good ideas!
- v. Bret Kuhns discussed the SPARK. The club was established in 1935. It has had a reinvigoration over the last 5 years. They have wanted to hold a state-wide convention, but never heard back from the ARRL on their inquiry.
- vi. The Missouri State Fair Grounds in Sedalia are available at \$1500 per day, plus 2% of admission charges. There is an adjacent building at \$180 per day which has additional classrooms. A third building could be available. Chairs, tables, and other equipment can be rented. There are ample motel rooms available in Sedalia.
- vii. A discussion ensued on how different clubs in the area can contribute to the effort. Clubs have different strengths and assets.
- viii. Timing was discussed. October 2025, was mentioned.
- ix. Location would be equidistant from St.Louis, Kansas City, and Springfield.

 There would be benefit to having a St. Louis club as a sponsor, in addition to the MOKAN clubs.




KcMesh status as of 18 April 2024


- 1 Operational link between Providence and St John hospital (Thanks To Rick NJOP).
